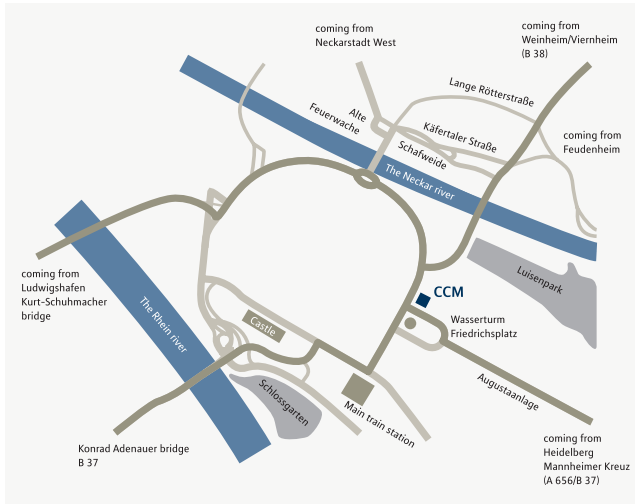


Travelling to the Congress Center Mannheim (CCM) Rosengarten, Mannheim



Arrival by car

At the A 6 or A 5 motorway intersections Mannheim or Heidelberg take the exit for “Mannheim-Mitte”. Follow the A 656 motorway in the direction of “Mannheim-Mitte” (passing the Planetarium and “Landesmuseum für Technik und Arbeit”), Augustaanlage, Friedrichsplatz and Wasserturm (Water Tower) to the CCM. Since March 2008, the Mannheim inner city area has been a low emission zone and access by car is only allowed for vehicles displaying an environment and fine dust permit.

Parking for shareholders

The underground parking facilities of the Congress Center Mannheim and the Dorint Congress Hotel offer parking spaces for 1,100 vehicles. Free parking for shareholders is only available in these two parking facilities.

Arrival by train

Mannheim is an ICE rail hub. It's about a five-minute walk (in the direction of the inner city) from the station to the Rosengarten – or you can take the tramline no. 3 or no. 5.

The admission ticket to the Annual General Meeting also entitles shareholders to free travel on the day of the event (5th June 2013) and until 3 a.m. of the following day on all buses, trams and designated trains (DB: RE, RB and S-Bahn railway lines – in each case, in second class) within the Rhein-Neckar Transport System (VRN).

Arrival by plane

Frankfurt am Main airport is directly linked with Mannheim via the ICE rail network (journey time 31 minutes). An hourly Lufthansa-shuttle bus service operates between the Lufthansa terminal at Frankfurt airport and Mannheim. Mannheim also has its own city airport.
